- Exposure to academic presentation & writing

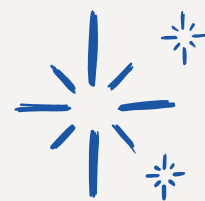
The commitment entails:

- Meetings with Drs. Reilly and/or Gorrell

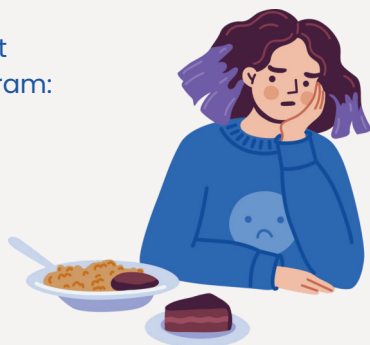

- Might computational modeling be an important tool in understanding therapeutic learning?
